General Information:

All cattle must be in place by 12:00 noon, Saturday, July 2, 2011, however, may not be on the grounds before 7:00 a.m. July 2.

Exhibitor's ticket	\$10.00	(Exhibitor and helper tickets are good only for July 2 through July 4)
Helper's ticket	\$10.00	
Season Pass	\$25.00	
Entry Fee	\$3.00 per class per animal	(Open Show many have two entries per class . Junior shows may have only one entry per class.)

Open Steer Entry fee \$30.00 per head

Camper fee \$25.00 per day

There are no stall fees. Superintendent will place specific breeds in AOB class if there are fewer than three (3) entries in a class.

Every person entering the fairgrounds must have a ticket, or be charged regular admission. There are no passes out or stamps..a ticket is needed every time one enters the fairgrounds. . One helper's ticket may be purchased with each exhibitor's pass purchased. All fees are the same for the Junior Show. Entries should be mailed to the Schuyler County Fair, P.O. Box 48, Rushville, Illinois by June 15, 2011. Please do not make entries by phone or through department superintendents.

Payment for all tickets, entry fees, and camper fees must accompany the entry form.

All cattle are to have health certificates. Papers will be checked in the barns. All breeding stock must have registration papers and be TB tested, if not from TB free herd or state, and be tested for brucellosis, except those vaccinated under 24 months of age.

All manure must be put in one of two piles at the east end of the barn. **No bedding will be furnished. Stalls must be cleaned by the exhibitor and gates returned to original places before checks are issued. Bring your own rakes and shovels, please.**

Only actual exhibitor showing can have exhibitor's number displayed. Premiums and placings are affected if helper's numbers are not hidden. Every exhibitor **must** wear a number in the show ring or placing and premium may be forfeited. All cattle will be released after checks have been issued on July 4, 2011. **An announcement will be made when checks are ready and where they may be picked up.**

Junior Show rules: Open to any Junior

All animals shown in the Junior Show must be the property of the boys and girls showing them. A Junior Exhibitor must be between 8 and 18 years of age as of January 1 of the year that the fair is held.

Each exhibit must be entered in the Junior's name, not under a farm name. All junior steers must prove validity of their breed, such as Land of Lincoln papers or Breeder's Certificate from their respective breeds. Every steer, not accompanied by said certificates will be shown as crossbred. The Junior Steer Show is by breed, not weight.

Only one entry per class in all Junior classes.

Schuyler-County-Only Junior Show

This show is for Schuyler County residents only and will precede the junior show open to all exhibitors.

Open Steer Show Rules:

1. An entry fee of \$30.00 must be paid when the entry is made. No refunds.
2. This class is open to anyone. You may have two entries.
3. The steers may be grade or purebred of any beef breed.
4. No exhibitor will be permitted to win more than two premiums in any class.
5. All steers must comply with the health rules and regulations.
6. All steers will be weighed July 2, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. Steer entry must be made before weigh-in.
7. Weight is divided equally in classes, to be determined by the superintendent. Classes are determined by weight, not breed and will be posted the evening of July 2.
