## Talent Show

1. Professional entertainers are not eligible.
2. Entries must be Schuyler County residents. In the case of group entries, at least one member must be a Schuyler County resident. There will be a review process to consider entries that do not meet this requirement.
3. Winning entries are expected to compete in the state talent competition representing Schuyler County. The runner-up may represent Schuyler County in the event the winner cannot compete.
4. The entry can represent only one county fair at the state level of competition.
5. Acts must observe a four (4) minute time limit. Acts running longer than the allowable time limit will be subject to disqualification.
6. Divisions for competition are as follows: SPARKLERS: All entries can be 8 years of age or younger on the day of competition. There is NO Sparkler division at the state level. If the entry wants to qualify for state competition, they must enter the Junior division.  
  
JUNIOR: Entries can be 14 years of age or younger on the day of competition. Junior division winners can be 15 years of age when competing at the state level the following January.  
SENIOR: Entries cannot be over 21 years of age on the day of competition. Senior division winners can be 22 years of age when competing at the state level the following January.
7. A piano will be the only equipment furnished.
8. There will be a panel of three judges and their decision will be final.
9. There will be a set-up time of three (3) minutes for each act.
10. When using cassettes or compact disc for accompaniment, they cannot have like talent on them, i.e., vocals, tap dancing, like instrument, etc.
11. Sportsmanship and responsible behavior will be expected of all entries.
